ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO REMAND

On July 5, 2011, the Court issued an Order that, among other things, denied Plaintiffs' motions to certify various multi-state classes. The Order also stated that "[i]n order to maximize the assistance provided to transferor courts, the undersigned intends to delay remand until after one or more cases have been litigated through final judgment." Plaintiffs now ask the Court to remand the transferred cases before litigating any cases, but the Court is not persuaded that its original intention should be altered. Therefore, the Motion to Remand (Doc. # 825) is denied.
